- Permanently affix the VECI and Vehicle Evaporative Hose Routing labels in accordance to the Installation Manual
- Ensure that the Installation Manual and Owner's Manual are provided to the ultimate purchaser
- Maintain for a period of not less than two years, written and photographic records of the following:
 - N/V ratio
 - Weight
 - Evaporative canister installation (photo)
 - Installation of VECI and Vehicle Evaporative Hose Routing labels (photographic)
 - Appearance of finished motorcycle from both right and left sides (photographic)
 - Evidence that oxygen sensor(s), if applicable, was installed in the correct location(s) (photographic)
 - Notify CARB within 10 days of completing first motorcycle where records will be kept and inspections can be performed
 - Provide immediate inspections of records documenting the proper assembly of each motorcycle upon request of CARB
 - Report VIN of newly built vehicles to S&S® Cycle, Inc
